Cask Ales

Ampersand (Norfolk) - On the Wing NEPA 4.7% - This beer is so new that we do not have any notes.

Arbor (Bristol) – M. Bomb 4.7% - Well hopped with Mosaic hops, tropical & blueberry flavours

C. Bomb 4.7% - Citra hops, lots of grapefruit & melon to the fore

Ascot (Surrey) – Shadowfax 4.8% NEW – Very refreshing, full of tropical flavours. NZ Hops

Billericay (Essex) – Zeppelin 3.8% - Pale ale with a crisp biscuit & caramel character

Bishop Nick (Essex) – Revelry 19 4.3% NEW – Golden Summer ale with a nice amount of bitterness

Blue Monkey (Notts) – Hop Air Balloon 3.6% NEW – No tasting notes. Tell us what you think!!

Boss (Swansea) – Nut Job 5.5% NEW – Real peanut butter in the mix, nice malty backbone.

Brockley Brewery (London) – Blueprint V2 4.1% - Very drinkable, special release. Lime aroma, dry-hopped with Ekuanot and Waimea

Calverleys (Cambridge) – Porter 5.1% - Champion porter@ GBBF Winter festival

Canopy (Herne Hill) – Sunray Pale 4.2% - Easy drinking, dry-hopped with Chinook hops

Castle Rock (Notts) – Session IPA 4.0% - Modern, juicy beer. Plenty of grapefruit & citrus flavours

Songbird 4.3% - Fruity, dry-hopped with Citra & Simcoe

Cliff Quay (Suffolk) – Scuttled 4.3% NEW – Pale, golden. Crisp, fruity aroma & biscuit malt flavour

Sea Dog 5.5% - Full-flavoured beer, bursting with lemon & grapefruit

Clouded Minds (Oxford) – Black Pike 6.1% - Medium bodied black IPA

Colchester (Essex) – Sweeney Todd 4.2% - Ruby with roasted malt flavours

Jester 4.5% NEW – Fruity, amber ale

Jumbo 6.6% - Full-bodied, dry stout

Collyfobble (Derby) – Bob on 3.8% - Traditional session bitter

Dancing Duck (Derby) - Quack me Amadeus 5.0% - Vienna-style lager, amber with a good body & hints of orange

Downton (Wilts) – Dark Delight 5.5% - Complex dark brown ale with a rich, hoppy aroma with coffee & chocolate flavours

Earl Soham (Suffolk) – Gannet Mild 3.3% - Well balanced mild, sweet & fruity

East London Brewery (Leyton) – Pearly Queen London Porter 4.5% - Limited edition, wheat based mahogany porter. Nutty aroma

Quadruped Black APA 5.3% - Very aromatic, deliciously flavoursome

Electric Bear (Bath) – (Ve) Whirly Bird 5.2% NEW – Unfined, no notes as too new

Fierce and Noble (Bristol) NEW BREWERY – Session IPA 4.2% - Too new no tasting notes

Firebird (Sussex) – (GF) Amarillo 4.1% - Well hopped pale ale

Golden Triangle (Norwich) – Le Ble Transatlantique 4.2% - Tasty wheat beer

Up City 4.5% - Oat pale ale with 4 hop varieties in the mix

Good Chemistry – (Bristol) – Boundless Sky 4.8%

Grafton (Worksop) – Cleopatra’s Needle 4.2% - Nicely balanced, copper ale

Grain (Norfolk) – Good Luck Mr Gorsky 5.5% - Hazy, soft pale with a spicy finish

Gt Heck (N. Yorks) – Dave 3.8% - Nicely balanced, red ale. “That you Dave?”

Cascade 4.5% - Golden ale, flowery & spicy with a hint of grapefruit

Hawks Head (Cumbria) – Bitter 3.7% - Well balanced thirst quencher

Lakeland Gold 4.4% - Fresh & hoppy, nice bitter after-taste

Hopkettle (Wilts) – Lupus 4.0% - Sorry, no notes

Humpty Dumpty (Norfolk) – Citrus Sunshine 4.1% - Dark golden beer with plenty of citrusy
American hops

21st Anniversary Barley wine 9.0% NEW – Rich & smooth ruby beer very drinkable for
its strength

Leigh on Sea (Essex) – (Ve) Kursall Gold 3.9% - Lightly hopped, citrus finish

(Ve) Six Little Ships 4.2% - Well balanced session ale

Lenton Lane (Notts) – 36 degrees North – Make your own mind up

Pugwash – No info as it is so new

Calibration 4.8% - Zesty, crisp, citrusy beer

Lincoln Green (Notts) – Goldzinger 4.5% NEW – Golden ale with citrus flavours

Mad Squirrel (Herts) – High Score 4.8% - A lager with attitude

Big Sea 5.5% - American IPA = Big citrus hops

Mighty Oak (Essex) – Here Comes the Summer 3.9% NEW - Blonde ale with Centennial hops. Perfect Summer beer

Cascade IPA 6.2% NEW – Robust IPA with a big floral aroma

Muirhouse (Derbys) – True Gent 4.3% - Pale, hoppy session ale

Navigation 9 Notts) – New Dawn 3.9% - Clean & sharp. Nice & hoppy

Nene Valley (Northants) – Manhattan Project 4.0% - Started off as a 1 off brew for The CB Blue, now a regular. Easy
drinking with tropical flavours

Egyptian Cream 4.5% - Wonderfully rich milk stout

Old Pie Factory (Warks) – Humble Pie 4.2% - Deep, red malty ale

Osset (W. Yorks) – Pekko 4.0% NEW – No tasting notes available

Parkway (Somerset) New Brewery – Giggle & Titter 3.8% - Light & very drinkable

Mumbo Jumbo 4.4% - Premium smooth blond ale

Little Ben's Midnight Express 4.8% - Rich & fruity dark porter

Potbelly (Northants) – Beijing Black 4.4% - Award winning mild

Round Corner (Leics) New Brewery – Summer Session Pale 3.9% - Nicely balanced session ale

Rudgate (York) – Jorvik 3.8% - Blond ale, nice balanced bitterness

Saltaire (W. Yorks) – South Island 3.5% - Super pale ale, tastes stronger than its ABV

Sambrooks (Battersea) – Junction 4.5% - Excellent example of a best bitter

Settle (N. Yorks) – Napier NZ 4.8% NEW – Crisp, full flavoured. Brewed exclusively with NZ hops

Shalford (Essex) – Stoneley Bitter 4.2% - Well balanced, best bitter

Shortts Farm (Suffolk) – Rockabilly 4.3% - American pale ale, very moreish

Siren Brewing (Berks) – Suspended in Idaho 4.0% NEW – Hazy, pale ale. Notes of tropical fruits & earthy pine

St Peter's (Suffolk) – Storm Trooper NEW -

Star Wing (Suffolk) – Dawn on the Border 3.7% NEW – Dry-hopped with Simcoe to give a full-flavoured beer

Stonehenge (Wilts) – Pigswill 4.0% - Amber session beer with full body

Tankleys (Enfield) – Session IPA 4.5% - Dry-hopped with Citra for lingering bitterness

The Park Brewery (London) Spankers 6.0% - Bold & juicy rich IPA. Orange & citrus flavours

Three Blind Mice (Cambs) (All Vegan) – Lek 3.7% - Lemongrass & lime wheat beer, light & citrusy

Juice Rocket 4.5% - An old favourite, bags of flavour

Zege 4.6% NEW – Belgian style, fruity pale ale

Hip Hip Puree 5.0% NEW – Collaboration with Wild Weather Bry, blackberry & rosehip. Sour

Three Castles (Wilts) Stoned 4.4% - Well-hopped to give intense citrus flavours

Three Sods (Bethnal Green) – Mon Cheri IPA 4.5% - Fresh tasting IPA

Timothy Taylor's (W. Yorks) – Boltmaker 4.0% - Tawny coloured best bitter

Ram Tam 4.3% - Dark, with a nice caramel flavour with a sweet finish. Not often found in this region

Titanic (Stoke on Trent) – Cherry Dark 4.4% - Powerful, sweet cherry flavour

Trumans (London) – Scorcher 4.2% - Packed with peach & orange flavours & aroma

Turpins (Cambs) – Strawberry Haze 3.9% - Smooth & refreshing with a hint of strawberries

(Ve) Moonjuice 5.0% - Juicy & refreshing

Winters (Norwich) – Peach Tea Pale 4.0% NEW –

Genius Stout 4.1% - Dark & fruity with malty molasses

Wolf (Norfolk) – Sly Wolf 4.0% NEW – Another one for you to tell us what you think

Mad Wolf 4.7% - Smooth & malty dark ale

Grandmas Rich Porter 5.0% - Rich & malty, long smooth finish

XT (Bucks) – Hopkitty 3.9% - Our house beer, light, refreshing, hoppy thirst quencher

Life in the Clouds 6.1% - Unfiltered NEIPA, lovely balance of malt & hops

Mash up the Jam 5.2% - Dry hopped sour, very refreshing

Stranger than Fiction 5.0% - Full bodied porter, massive chocolate hit & roast malt

Curious (Ashford Kent) – Session IPA 4.4% - Triple hopped, refreshing session beer

Dig Brew (Birmingham) – My other painting is a car 5.0% - Pale session ale with Citra, Mosaic & Belma hops

Gorgeous (Tottenham) – Greaseball APA 5.4% - Long lingering finish with resinous pine & citrus notes

Mothership (Bermondsey) – Hypergalactic IPA 6.4% - Huge amounts of hops used in this brew. Award winning beer

One Mile End (London) – Pierre de Garde 10% - French farmhouse style ale. Imperial strength, sweet caramel & toffee flavours

Ora (Tottenham) – Limoncello IPA 6.5% - Couldn't resist getting this one. Flaked oats, lactose & Italian lemons.

Partizan (Bermondsey) – X-Ale 1885 5.3% - A very modern twist on a mild. Gooseberries, lime & a little sulphur
